This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made & entered into on 9-02-20217 between

Aditya Degree College for Women, Kakinada (hereinafter referred as ADCW-KKD) Whereas ADCW-KKD is "Approved by APSCHE and affiliated to Adikavi Nannaya University, Rajamahendravaram and City Online AP Private Limited, Kakinada, Andhra Pradesh (hereinafter referred as CO)

Purpose:

The MoU is being signed with CO as a partner to offer training on Net Working to the students of ADCW-KKD in Electronics and MPAIR specializations. This MoU between ADCW-KKD and CO will outline the Networking skills to the students of ADCW-KKD by the CO networking experts.

Context:

ADCW-KKD is working to improve the Net Working skills to its Electronics and MPAIR students and in the process ADCW-KKD is, exploring, partnership, with different stakeholders and has identified, CO, as a potential partner.

As part of this MoU, both the parties hereto agree to the following respectively:

- 1. ADCW-KKD has approached CO to offer effective networking skills to its electronics and MPAIR students.
- 2. CO has considered ADCW-KKD request and agreed to offer networking skills to the electronics and MPAIR of ADCW-KKD at ADCW-KKD campus by the CO networking experts.
- 3. The transportation charges of the CO personnel should bear by ADCW-KKD or reimburse the charges to the CO personnel on actuals.
- 4. ADCW-KKD agreed to pay Rs.2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) per student for entire training program.
- 5. ADCW-KKD will access the networking skills of its students by the third party after successful completion of training by CO experts.

6. Based on the successful report of third party on each student, ADCW-KKD will pay the training charges to the CO.

7. CO should offer additional training to the unsuccessful students identified by the third party.

8. No extra charges will pay by the ADCW-KKD for additional training offered by CO

9. Both the parties may terminate this MoU with the notice period of one month. In this context, both the parties have to discharge their obligation.

VALIDITY

This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period, the Second Part.

RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MoU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MoU shall not be construed as a partnership.
