Aditya Degree and P G College NSS Unit 1 successfully conducted a One-Day NSS Programme as per the circular of **Department of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India**. The NSS Unit of our college conducted this program by having a lecture session in the morning and in the afternoon session. Drug addiction has become a serious concern in the country, especially among the younger generation. Its effects are not limited to the person using drugs but extend to families, communities, and society at large. The rise in substance abuse has contributed to an increase in crime rates and has had an overall damaging impact on social well-being. Hon’ble Prime Minister in his ‘Mann ki Baat’ in December 2014 had highlighted how “The drug menace brings about the Three D’s. First D is Darkness, the second D is Destruction, and the third D is Devastation.” The Government, since 2014, has been making concerted efforts to counter this threat, which has helped strengthen the actions and cooperation to achieve the goal of a society free of drug abuse.

The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (MoSJE) is the nodal Ministry for Drug Demand Reduction and, as part of its mandate, has introduced measures to curtail substance abuse in the country. MoSJE formulated and enacted the National Action Plan for Drug Demand Reduction (NAPDDR). The scheme focuses on preventive education, awareness generation, identification, counselling, treatment, rehabilitation of individuals with substance dependence, training, and capacity building of the service providers through collaborative efforts of the Central and State Governments and Non-Governmental Organizations. Nasha Mukht Bharat Abhiyaan (NMBA) was launched on 15th August 2020 by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment in 272 Districts identified as most vulnerable in terms of substance use. The Abhiyaan on 15th August 2023 has been expanded to all Districts of the country. Being a campaign mode programme, the Abhiyaan has targeted and involved stakeholders that might be directly or indirectly affected by substance abuse and those who are vulnerable to it. The major stakeholders and beneficiaries of the NMBA are Youth, Women, Children, Educational Institutions, Civil Society, and the Community at large.

In order to execute this program, the NSS Unit formally conveyed this desire to the Management of Aditya Institutions through our Principal Mr. Vilas Anil Chavan, who immediately consented to this important order of APSCHE and gave us the needed permission to have this one-day program. The College NSS Unit Programme Officer Mr. B K Vidyasagar after having received the necessary permission started the co-ordinating process to have a One-Day program comprising a lecture session and an essay writing competition.

In the morning session a lecture was presented which started immediately after the college assembly at around 10 O clock. Ms V Rohini Associate Professor, Department of Forensic Sciences, Aditya University spoke on the various aspects and issues related to drug abuse and effects of alcohol on individuals and especially young boys and girls studying in our universities and colleges. The NSS Student Volunteers also prepared some colourful posters and pictures related to the significance of the program. They went around the campus to the Engineering Colleges and Polytechnic Colleges and had meaningful interactions and spread the awareness of drug abuse and alcohol usage with all the students

We had another activity in the afternoon session, an Essay Writing Competition open for all the students. The NSS Unit provided all the logistics for the students who were taking part in this Competition. It was held in the Forensic Sciences 'Library' with the support of the Librarian Mr. Veeraswamy and under the supervision of Mr B K Vidyasagar NSS Programme Officer and Mr B V S S Udayanadh, Faculty Asst Co-ordinator. The Essay Writing topics which are as follows,

* Drug addiction: Impact on Young Lives * Impact of Drugs & Tobacco on Health issues *Drugs & Alcohol consumption; Influences Crime & Violence in people's lives*.

As soon as the Certificates were distributed NSS student volunteer Ms Lakshmi Gayathri gave a vote of thanks. The program ended successfully and we all gathered in the college Seminar Hall for singing the National Anthem and dispersed after the college closing bell.

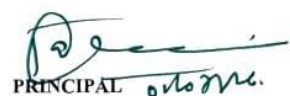
