INAUGURATION:

Time: 11.00 am - 11.30 am

ADDRESS BY PRINCIPAL, ADPGC:

INITIATING THE EVENT:

Time: 11.30 am

The ceremony proceeded with a demonstration of the event guidelines. The official collection of fingerprints began at 11:30 am, with Sri Vilas Anil Chavan, Principal of ADPGC, collecting the fingerprints of the Principal of AGBS.



On the ground floor, 37 student volunteers were organized at 15 desks to collect fingerprints from participants. Each desk had assigned volunteers for data entry. As the timer started at 11:30 am, participants from the Forensic Science department provided their fingerprints to the volunteers. Fingerprint cards had been distributed in advance to all participants from the Forensic Science department and AGBS. Student volunteers efficiently organized and guided the participants to the 15 desks.



By 12:00 noon, it was recorded that 630 ten-digit fingerprints were collected within 30 minutes. After the Forensic Science department participants, those from AGBS were guided to provide their fingerprints. Faculty members and non-teaching staff also volunteered. By 12:30 pm, the student volunteers had completed the fingerprint collection. Final counting of the recorded fingerprint sheets revealed a total number of 1095 ten-digit prints out of which 1037 fingerprints were considered to be reliable.
